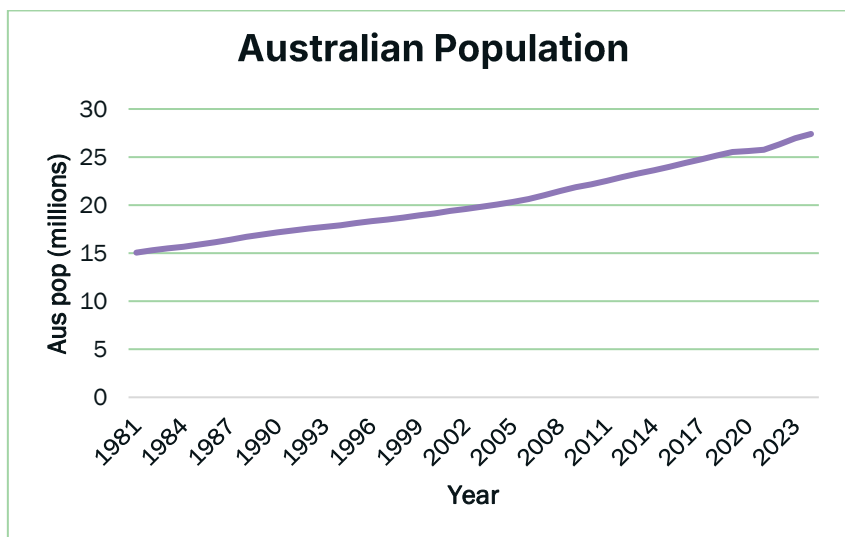
AUSTRALIA'S POPULATION 2025

Australia's estimated resident population was 27.5 million in March 2025. Of these, approximately 8.6 million people were born overseas, accounting for 31.5% of the population. The average age of Australians was 39.5 years.

According to estimates from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS), in 2025 Australia's population increased by one person every 1 minute and 10 seconds. This net growth reflects the combined effects of births, deaths, and migration, including:

- One birth every 1 minute and 49 seconds
- One death every 2 minutes and 50 seconds
- One new migrant arriving every 52 seconds
- One Australian leaving to live overseas every 2 minutes and 1 second
