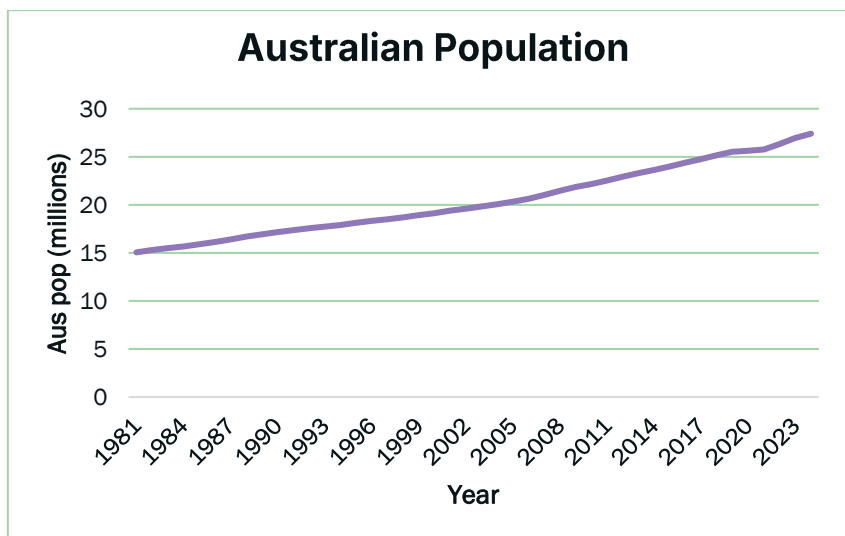
AUSTRALIA'S POPULATION

Australia's current estimated resident population is approximately 28 million people. Of these, approximately 8.6 million people were born overseas, accounting for 31.5% of the population. The average age of Australians was 39.5 years.

According to estimates from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS), Australia's population increases by one person every 1 minute and 15 seconds. This net growth reflects the combined effects of births, deaths, and migration, including:

- One birth every 2 minute and 16 seconds
- One death every 3 minutes and 33 seconds
- One new migrant arriving every 59 seconds
- One Australian leaving to live overseas every 1 minute and 15 seconds
