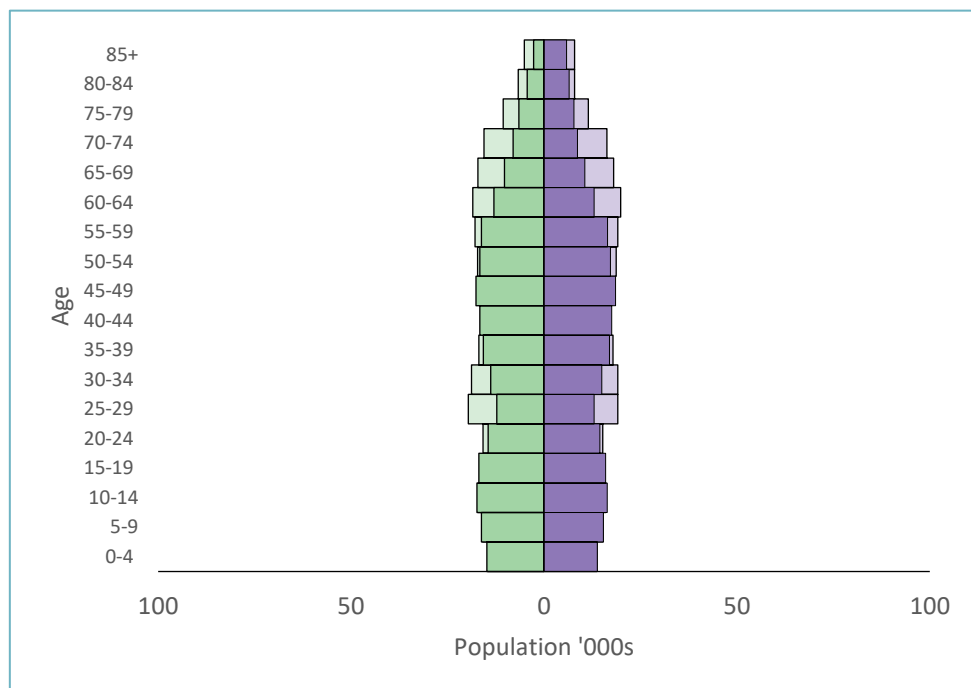
TASMANIA POPULATION

Tasmania (TAS) is Australia's only island state, located south of the mainland across the Bass Strait. Established as a separate colony in 1825, it's known for its rugged wilderness, cool climate, and unique wildlife, with Hobart serving as its historic and cultural centre.

- In TAS, the average number of children a woman will bear is around 1.49 babies per woman.
- Life expectancy in TAS is at 80.2 for men, and 84 for women.
- Over the last year, TAS gained 3,182 residents via net overseas migration, and lost 2,217 residents via net interstate migration.

In 2025, an estimated 576,100 people resided in TAS
